Uruguay Clash Leaves 4 Dead

MONTEVIDEO, Uruguay, Oct. 9 (UPI).—Police said Thursday that four persons were killed and at least seven wounded in a terrorist raid Wednesday on the small town of Pando. About 40 raiders from the leftist underground organization Tupamaros invaded the town in five cars disguised as a funeral procession to capture the police station, the fire station, the phone exchange and rob four bank branches.

The town of 20,000 about 18 miles from Montevideo was a battleground for an hour and a half. Police said the terrorists seized \$168,000 at the banks, but most of it was recovered.

Three of the raiders and a bystander were killed and 16 of the raiders were captured.
