Killed in Holdup

MONTIVIDEO, Uruguay (AP) - A former Roman Catholic priest, reported to be a leader of an urban guerrilla group, died Thursday of wounds suffered in the attempted holdup of a weapons store. Police identified the guerrilla as Indalecio Olivera Ramos, 34, a former local prelate who took off his cassock to become a member of the pro-Peking group known as the National Liberation Movement.
